

## **LAPTOP RECOMMENDATIONS**

- **OS**: Windows 10 or 11; macOS 11(Big Sur) or Newer.
- **Processor**: i5
- **RAM**: 16 GB preferred, 8GB minimum
- **Storage**: at least 500GB SSD (Solid State Drive)

- Be up-to-date with security patches
- Bring assorted cords, cables, and connectors We do not provide Ethernet cables or Ethernet dongle







#### WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Access Points
- Wireless Routers


## **CAMPUS-WIDE WIRELESS NETWORK (WI-FI)**

- **FMU\_Guest** (Unsecured with slower connection)
- Wifi . **FMU** (Secured network with more bandwidth)
  - **Eduroam** (secure, world-wide roaming access service developed for the international research and education community)
  - Join with your Patriot Portal username (everything before the @ symbol of your FMU issued email) and password
  - **DO NOT CONNECT**: Wireless printers, gaming consoles, smart TVs, Apple TV, Chromecast, Roku,-Hardwire if possible




#### **CAMPUS PRINTING**

- Printing of coursework and documents may be done from any public lab.
- A one-time process to associate your Student ID card to Campus Print Services.
- Students have a yearly allocation for page prints for a value of \$12.50 on your ID card.
  - $\circ~$  Black & White 6¢ per print
  - $\circ$  Color 10¢ per print
- If the allocation is exceeded, then you can log into **OneWeb** to add funds to your account.

## **CAMPUS PRINTING** – Adding funds through oneweb

- OneWeb Go to https://oneweb.fmarion.edu
  - **Account = Student ID Number**
  - **Default Password** = Date of Birth (MMDDYYYY
  - (You can Create/Reset your Password by clicking ACCOUNT SETTINGS & following the directions)
- Once logged in, Click <u>ADD CASH</u> to your FMU ID Card
- Enter the amount you want to deposit in the **Deposit Amount** Box & click **Continue**.
- You will be redirected to a secure site to fill out your Debit or Credit Card information.
